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US patent 9,315,495 (April 9, 2016) “Antibacterial agents: Aryl Myxopyronin Derivatives” was awarded to Rutgers University based on a research collaboration between Prof. Richard Ebright and his lab at Rutgers and the Provid team.

The co-inventors include Prof. Ebright (Board of Governors Professor of Chemistry and Chemical Biology at Rutgers University and Laboratory Director at the Waksman Institute of Microbiology), members of the Ebright lab, and the team at Provid pharmaceuticals Inc. The Provid co-inventors are Drs. Gary Olson, Christopher Self, James Bacci, and Anne-Cecile Hiebel, and William Solvibile. The research was funded by an NIH grant awarded by the National Institutes of Health to Prof. Ebright (AI090837) with funding shared with Provid co-investigators.
